

# AUTUMN GLORY MINISTRIES- OCTOBER 15, 2011

Remember that wherever you are scheduled to work a positive Christian attitude is everything! Be sure to talk with those at your station and engage them in conversation. Be ready to share about Christ and talk to them about their faith as you work in each area. You never know when God will open the door to share the gospel.

## Ministries at the Children's Tent:

**Baby Comfort Station:** Two women will be stationed to help mothers that come to use the station for nursing and changing diapers. You will be in charge of welcoming them, showing them to the station, and wiping down the areas after they have been used.

**Popcorn Machine:** You will be making popcorn and passing it out to people in line. One person will scoop it up and another will give it to the patron. You will also be in charge on cleaning up the machine at the end of the day.

**Coffee/Hot Chocolate Station:** This person will help to make and pass out the coffees and hot chocolates to those in line.

**Handwashing Station:** Two people will sit at our hand washing table by the port-o-pots and make sure it is kept filled up with soap and paper towels. You are one of our most appreciated ministries. Be sure to direct people to our tent.

## Crafts:

**Pumpkins-** One person will help with this craft. Be sure to go over each color of fabric and use the colors to share the gospel with them. The pumpkin is made with toilet paper and material squares.

**Sand Art-** This is new this year! Children can make sand art bracelets. You will there to give instructions and a helping hand. Also to make sure supplies are ready to go!

**Candles-** Children can also make candles out of baby food jars and tealights. Helpers will be offering assistance and talking with the families.

**FacePainting:** Two- three people will be manning this station. You will be face painting.

**Splat Tattoos:** One- Two people will have Splat Tattoos ready to place on children. You will use this as a witnessing tool while you apply the tattoo.

**Walking Sticks:** Two to three people needed to pass out walking sticks and share the gospel with those receiving them.

Prayer Booth: One- two people will be needed to take prayer requests and work the information table of the tent. You will be answering questions and sharing with others.

Line Greeters: As you see lines forming at various ministry parts of the tent, be sure to go over and greet people. Welcome them to our tent and ask if they have any questions. This is a great opportunity to share Christ.

## Outside of Tent:

Parade Spacers: Ten people will stand in groups of two along the parade route. You will be responsible for keeping the parade flowing. You will use signs that say "Slow Down" or "Speed Up". We are volunteers of the Chamber of Commerce for this activity. So please try to do your best and be as professional as possible. Make sure you and your partner have the same side of the sign showing. The parade is approx. 2 hours long, so be ready to stand for about that amount of time. It begins at 1:00 p.m.

Banner Holders: We may be asked to help hold title banners up and walk with that unit during the parade. This would be a new ministry this year and not a definite yet.

Tent set-up/take-down: We need between 12-15 men with sledgehammers to help put up our huge tent @ 8:00 A.M.. You will also need to help with the take down at 3:30 PM.

Radio Assistant during parade: I need one person to help to radio changes in parade units for the radio station announcing the event. You will be given a radio to receive changes on and to relay information to the radio announcers. If you have experience with radio, this is a plus.

Grandstand Set-up: This year we will be needing helpers to help set up chairs for the grandstand area Sat. morning.

\*At the end of the day, you will need to be ready to clean up the area that you worked in. This will help to ensure a quick & smooth clean up and tent take down.

If anyone has a pick-up truck we can use to load up supplies, let me know. We will load it up Friday night after the orientation meeting, so it is ready to go!

\*\*You will want to bring a bagged lunch and snacks for the day. There are vendors around, but the lines are usually very long!!!
